

Translate the following sentences.

1. Therefore, the king loves all his sons. (See 5.4)
2. In Ayodhyā, all sons of the king are handsome.
3. The angry brāhman does not hear the words of the king's wife.
4. All righteous kings rule for the sake of their subjects.
5. Kings do not perform sacrifices without brāhmans. (See 4.42.b.)
6. Because of those (two) sacrifices, the kingdom is peaceful.
7. King Daśaratha loved especially his eldest offspring. (Use स्म—sma.)
8. But, in the course of time, the two wives forget the sacrifice.
9. With those wives, the heroes dwell in Ayodhyā.
10. Rāma goes to the forest for the sake of righteous people.
11. The hero hears the words of his wife and becomes angry.
12. Joyfully the girl thinks, "I am listening to the adventures of Rāma."
